Each participant will receive his or her own money box. As kids go door-to-door collecting treats, they'll also have the opportunity to raise funds for a great




cause: supporting children living with type 1 diabetes.

We're counting on your presence at the cost of **\$10 per adult and \$5 per child** to make this event a memorable one.


